Dear Road Cyclist Enthusiast,

Entries for the Nedbank WPP 2 race are now open. Please log on to the ChronoTrack <u>link</u>, select the relevant category and complete the required fields.

**Please note:** To avoid serious collusions at the finish line, no spectators or parked cars will be allowed at least 100m from the finish line.

### More about the Nedbank WPP 2:

The first race will take place on B1 Road towards Okahanja, 21st January 2024.

Start and Finish: Start will be on the Eastern down ramp heading to Namwater Bridge, with finish on the Eastern up ramp, coming from Teufelsbach. Loops will continue on the B1 through, under the Bridge/Crossover.

Starting time: 07:00

Race log: For all the various distances and starting times refer to the Race log

MTB RIDERS: No Slick tyres allowed in the MTB.

INDIVIDUAL RIDERS: Should entries exceed a predetermined number, start times may be split to allow for safe starts and racing.

SCHOOLS: Only the first 5 to finish in the School Teams category will count towards the team standings on the day.

SUPPORT: Support vehicles are not allowed to pace their riders back to the team under any circumstances and no riders may ride in a car's slip. Any rider caught behind a car will result in the team's disqualification. Only 1 support vehicle per team.

SUPPORT: Support vehicles for U/10 Boys and Girls and Men's and Ladies teams only, strictly no other start groups. All the general support car rules will apply.

SUPPORT: Support cars are to remain at least 20m behind the bunch. Have your hazards on at all times.

SUPPORT: Support car drivers need to be aware of their surroundings and all cyclists at all time.

SUPPORT: If a cyclist and/or a support car need to stop for any reason, please ensure that you move completely off the road.

SUPPORT: As a safety precaution, support vehicles are not allowed to drive next to a bunch to communicate with a cyclist.

SUPPORT: Availability of support vehicles are the teams own responsibility and not that of the WPP Committee.

TEAMS: Teams are allowed to share equipment/ parts with other teams during techicals.

TEAMS: Captains to sign-in at the registration table, confirming team members entered and racing on the day.

Cyclists must feed at the back of the bunch only. Feeding on the side of the bunch is prohibited. No feeding on First and Last Lap allowed.

Cyclist may not slip from another start group, only in their own start group. (THIS APPLIES TO TEAMS AS WELL)

Earphones are not permitted during a race. Failure to adhere to this will result in DQ.

In the interest of rider safety, NO RIDING IN THE RIGHT HAND LANE will be allowed. Crossing of the line will result in a DQ.

No spectators or parked cars allowed 100m from the FINISH LINE, to avoid collision with rider sprint finishes.

Traffic rules are to be obeyed at all times.

Important: Please keep a distance of at least 10 meters from the timing device after finishing.

Result queries will be accepted until Monday 18:00 where after no more changes nor corrections will be done.
